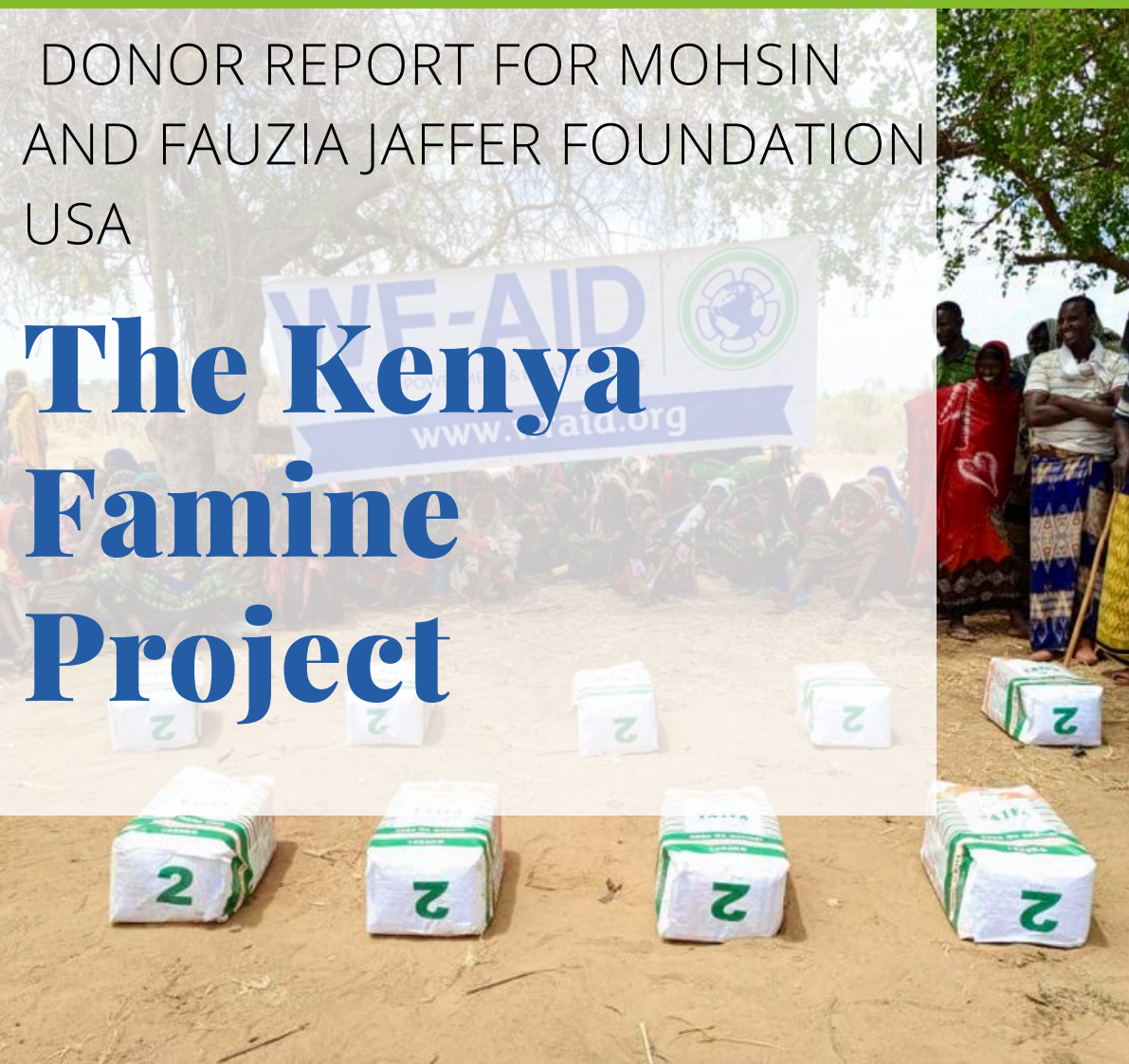

INTRODUCTION

Over 4 million Kenyans faced starvation during the year 2022 due to a protracted drought. Plenty of people risked losing their lives if no intervention was put in place, having lost their source of food and water with the drying of their crops and water. The crisis has been an extension of food insecurity experienced in the previous years which only worsened with time, with very little food production and exhaustion of food reserves leading to widespread food insecurity.



CHAKAMA

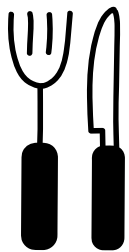
Chakama, located in remote Kilifi County, is one such location where communities are facing starvation. For many years the villages in Chakama have been neglected therefore having poor accessibility due to a lack of basic infrastructure such as roads. Trade is therefore minimal. They are also uneducated and unemployed, having little economic activities to earn a living. They mostly rely on subsistent farming to obtain food but due to harsh environmental and climatic factors, they grow very little. Furthermore, the little they can grow is commonly destroyed by free moving domestic as well as wild animals, pests, drought and floods. Surveys conducted by our team in various parts of the country revealed a desperate situation.

PROVISION OF AID

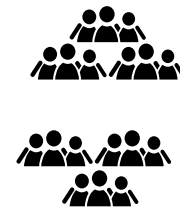
To avert potential loss of lives, through support from Mohsin and Fauzia Jaffer Foundation (MFJ) and our ground partners, WF-AID distributed 30 tons of relief food to 780 of the most vulnerable households in 6 villages of the Chakama location. These households included destitute widows, orphans, the elderly and the disabled. These food packets included 24kg of maize flour, 10kg of beans, and 1 kg of salt.



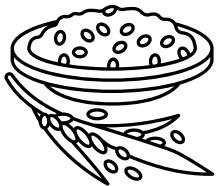

AGE: 79 YEARS

- Mohamed is a 79 yrs old elderly man who lives with his family in the Ropih village of Chakama.
- They benefitted from relief food that was distributed through sponsorship from WF-AID. When our volunteers visited him he narrated that it had been a struggle for him to provide for his large family of 13.
- He and his family are subsistent farmers however due to the recurrent drought in Chakama, they have suffered low yield from their farming.
